Third-party verified corporate sustainability reports (CSR), which include environmental impacts of extraction operations and activities associated with the manufacturer's product and the product's supply chain, are valued as one whole product for credit achievement calculation.

Kährs audited EU EMAS-Sustainability Report

Wood products must be certified by the Forest Stewardship Council[®] or USGBC-approved equivalent. Products meeting wood products criteria are valued at 100% of their cost for the purposes of credit achievement calculation.

This credit contains two options, with the second focused on "leadership extraction practices." To receive the credit, a project must use "at least 25%, by cost, of the total value of permanently installed building products." For wood products, the credit requires products "certified by the Forest Stewardship Council® or USGBC-approved equivalent."
